

Life Skills Psychiatric Rehabilitation Program (PRP)





DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

We offer a variety of services including onsite, outreach, telehealth and virtual.

ONSITE SERVICES provide the opportunity to participate in skills based groups, interact with peers, and meet individually with their rehabilitation coordinator.

COMMUNITY OUTINGS

promote socialization and Independence

TELEHEALTH check in calls are conducted weekly by rehabilitation coordinators to provide support, discuss coping skills, and advance individual goals.

OUTREACH staff meet with clients at their home and/or in community settings to provide services.

VIRTUAL participation in groups allows clients to engage with others in a virtual environment.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

PRP services are provided to adults (18+) with a primary behavioral health diagnosis and a desire to participate in services voluntarily.

Interested individuals need to have a completed PRP referral form from a licensed mental health practitioner and be in active treatment.

PAYMENT/FUNDING

PRP services are funded primarily by Medicaid. Other payment options may be available to those who are uninsured. Please call for more information about our fees.
